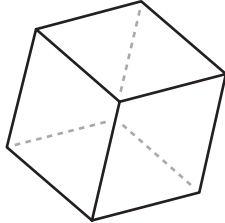

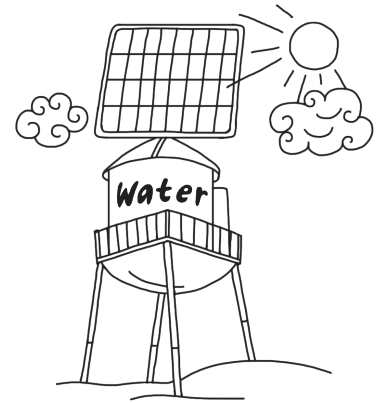
Twenty-sixth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Fabiano in Uganda now has water near his vegetable garden, thanks to CAFOD supporters.

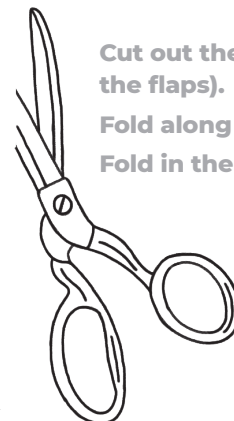
