

Raising awareness... *From a distance*

1. Run an assembly

Ask for an assembly slot. Even if these are not happening in person, you could pre-record or live-stream your assembly or collective worship. Send it to form/ tutor groups to watch together.

2. Share a video

Last year, one group filmed their teachers answering the question 'Why is peace important' and shared it with their school. Could you do something similar?

3. Display your message

Is there a space in the chapel or corridor that you can use to create a display on your chosen SDG? You can order free posters from CAFOD's online shop. You could also ask for space in your school newsletter to raise awareness.

4. Competition Exhibition

Can you set your peers a challenge to take a photo or create a piece of art related to your SDG? Share these as a 'virtual exhibition' on your group's Instagram page or ask the school for space on the website.

5. Lead by example

A great way to raise awareness is through action. Why not try living on £5 for a whole week and write about your experience. Share your story with CAFOD so we can share it too.

6. The power of social media

Set up an Instagram or twitter account for your Young Leader group that your teachers and classmates can follow. Use this platform to spread positive messages and information about your SDG. Tag @CAFOD in your posts so we can help spread your message too.

7. Press release

Your local press love to hear from you! Could you write a press release about what you are doing in school and why it is so important? Or contact your local radio and talk to them about young leaders or social justice. Contact youth@cafod.org.uk for more information.

8. Take it to the top!

Have you noticed a problem at school? There are no recycling bins in school or not enough trees? Arrange a meeting with your Head of Year or Senior Leadership Team. Be prepared. Tell them why it's important to you and suggest solutions!
